*The Presbytery of Chicago requires all ministers, ministerial candidates and inquirers, Honorably Retired clergy, Certified Christian Educators, members of the Presbytery Coordinating Commission, moderators of any of the presbytery's entities, and all Presbytery of Chicago employees and volunteers to attend a seminar on healthy boundaries every three years.

A 5 hour class is needed for all first time members of the presbytery. Thereafter, a 3 hour class is required to renew certification.
