

Director of Youth and Family Ministry

Position:

Director of Youth and Family Ministry - Full Time (~ 40 hrs./week)

Responsibilities:

- Provide an active spiritual ministry to our Middle and High School youth and their parents.
- Plan and teach a 50-minute Christian education program for senior high students once per week on Sunday morning.
- Plan, lead and support the Summer Youth Mission Trip.
- Support youth and family related fund raising events throughout the year.
- Organize and manage monthly Youth Ministries Team meetings.
- Provide periodic Worship assistance in the Sunday worship services as well as assist in weddings, baptisms and funerals when requested by the Senior Pastor. □
- Render meaningful assistance to the Senior Pastor during Holy Week, the Christmas season and vacation schedules. □
- Serve as administrative and organizational coordinator between key staff and volunteers.
- Be present each week to meet and greet families and youth at Church Fellowship hour Sunday morning after worship. Follow-up on youth and family concerns expressed.
- Assist with in-home visitations of church family as requested by the Senior Pastor.
- Work with Confirmation team, as requested by the Senior Pastor and the Christian Education Committee.
- Coordinate and publicize all youth events using emails, facebook, twitter, flyers, etc. to youth and parents as necessary. Periodically update the Youth Ministries page of the PRPC website for youth related information (www.parkridgepresby.org).
- Coordinate and communicate with the CE Director and committee as necessary.
