

Advisory Opinion "Re-Opening Sanctuaries for Worship" Presbytery of Chicago – Presbytery Coordinating Commission Approved June 2, 2020

As your Session deliberates a forward plan for resuming corporate worship in church sanctuaries, the Presbytery Coordinating Commission (PCC) of Chicago Presbytery offers this advisory opinion.

Based on advice from the "Restore Illinois Plan" and our PC(USA) polity and policies, we recommend that church Sessions take action to continue online virtual worship services and/or "drive in" worship services at least through Sunday, August 30, 2020, and refrain from physically gathering in church sanctuaries until after this date.

We hope that by this point in time conditions will be safe to allow churches to begin worshipping in person again.
